



## ELIGIBILITY & ENROLLMENT

### WHO ARE CHICAGO COMMONS ADULT DAY CARE CENTER CLIENTS?

Chicago Commons' clients are seniors over age 60, or adults between 18-60 with cognitive and/or physical impairments who need care or socialization during the day.

### HOW DO I ENROLL MY LOVED ONE IN CHICAGO COMMONS' ADULT DAY CARE CENTER ?

You can also enroll through:

1. The Community Care Program of the Illinois Department on Aging (IDOA) 1-800-252-8966.
2. The Office of Rehabilitation Services (312) 782-2722.
  - **Your senior or adult disabled is eligible for Community Care Program (CCP) or Office of Rehabilitation (ORS) services if he or she is:**
    - age 60 or older (**CCP**)
    - between the ages of 18-60 (**ORS**)
    - determined physically in need of service
    - a resident of the State of Illinois
    - a United States citizen or legal alien
  - AND**
  - meets the asset requirements, which will be explained to you when the case manager comes to your home.
3. On a Private Pay Basis - Please contact Chicago Commons Adult Day Care Center directly at (773) 373-5055 for our private pay scale.
