**Chicago Commons Homemaker Services** helps seniors remain living at home by providing a variety of services including, but not limited to assistance with household tasks such as cleaning/light housekeeping, personal care, medication reminders, planning and preparing meals, doing laundry, shopping, running errands, escorting to appointments, and "welcome back" care after hospital stays.
