We appreciate your patience as we navigate this complicated COVID-19 landscape. As you know, we have been following guidance from key departments at the State of Illinois and City of Chicago on how to respond and prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Earlier this month, Governor Pritzker extended the Stay at Home Order through Thursday, April 30th in the best interest of the health and safety of the public. In alignment, Chicago Public Schools extended their closure through April 30.

In concert with the City of Chicago and State of Illinois, we have decided to extend the closure of our Adult Day Service Center in Bronzeville indefinitely until further notice

This is not a decision we take lightly, but know it is something we must do for the safety of our communities and families. We know that this message brings about many questions. Please know that we fully intend to open when it is deemed safe to do such. **We will keep you notified as the situation changes.**
